ENTRY AND TICKETING

There are no entry fees to enter the Calf and Lamb Competition. All entries received by Friday 6th October will be sent ONE CHILD ticket for entry. Accompanying adults will need to pay the full gate fee.

Entries will be taken right up until the day, however tickets will not be posted to anyone after 6th October.

ALL PRIZE MONEY WILL BE PAID OUT AT THE SHOW.

Entries will be accepted from a School or Individuals. Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times.

Penning is available to competitors in the covered Sheep Pavilion before and after the competition. Penning and vehicle access is through Gate 13 off Elwood Road.

Animals will be need to be led to the Parade ring around the back Trades fence. A Marshall will collect all competitors and animals from the Sheep Pavilion and escort them to the Parade ring at 10.45am.

Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal legislation and the Health and Safety in Employment Act 1992 and any amendments thereafter.
