Each Exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness, or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds. Exhibitors must comply with appropriate animal legislation and the health and safety in employment act 1992 and any amendments thereafter.

Confirmation of entries will be sent to each exhibitor once their entry has been received by the Show Secretary. Tickets will be posted with your confirmation of entries and will include information regarding stalls, parking and Show maps.

VENUE:

To be run adjacent to the Exhibition Hall on Wednesday, Thursday, commencing at 7.30am. The Final will be on Friday. Parking will be in the Dog Trial Park – entry off Karamu Road.

Run under the Rules of the Hawke's Bay Show Dog Trial Committee. A Hydatids Certificate is required.

A call off system may be used at the discretion of the Judge.
