Entry Fee: \$10 per entry (GST & Penning Inclusive) Prize Money: 1st \$100, 2nd \$50, 3rd \$25.

Enter a pen of three lambs for a Hook and Hoof competition - all lambs will be judged on the Hoof on Wednesday 23 October and then trucked to the Progressive Meats Hastings plant to be killed on Wednesday afternoon.

All lambs must be GRASS FED, ANTIBIOTIC & GMO FREE and have FULL LIFETIME TRACEABILITY – meaning having never been fed grain or given antibiotics. You will need to sign a NON GMO declaration stating your lambs have never eaten genetically modified food

ASD Form Requirements:

- Please use latest version of the Atkins Ranch or Progressive Meats ASD Form with Quality Assurance Declaration completed
- **If you require an ASD form, they will be available on Wednesday 23 October at the Showground Yards**

Unless proceeds are donated to the Hawke's Bay Rugby Union & Hawke's Bay A & P Society partnership Club (see on next page), kill proceeds will be paid 14 days after kill, direct to Exhibitors less normal kill charges on the Atkins Ranch schedule on the day.

All 3 lambs must grade as per the requirements for each class to be eligible for the Hook and Best Overall prizes.

Teeth criteria – lambs will be disqualified when **both** new teeth are in wear.

Best Pen of 3 on Hoof will be judged on a combination of Condition, Conformation and Presentation with an even line of lambs gaining more points and extra points for Judges Pick.

Best Pen of 3 on Hoof will be judged on a combination of Dress out Yield, Hot Carcass Weight, and GR (target GR is 8 – 10mm). Exhibitors will receive individual lamb results for Dress Out Yield, HCW, and GR.

Penning and Judging on Hoof Wednesday 23rd October

Timing: Wednesday 23rd October Penning: 8am - 9am / Judging 9am – 10am.

Access to the Showgrounds for delivery for competition is via Gate 13 on Elwood Road. All penning and judging is done at the Sheep Pavilion. Competitors are able to remain onsite while judging takes place, morning tea will be provided.

Final results and Presentation Thursday 24th October

A ticket to the New Zealand Royal A&P Show will be sent to each competitor to attend the Thursday Presentation.

The **Supreme Carcass** will be on display Thursday prior to being used in the afternoon in a boning demonstration. The **Supreme carcass** will be presented to winning competitor processed and freezer ready.

Presentation of hoof and hook results and prizes will take place on Thursday 24th October from 3.30pm at the Sheep Pavilion and all competitors are welcome to join in with the hospitality at the Stockmans Baar with a BBQ supplied by the Atkins Ranch and Progressive Meats Livestock Teams.
