CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Entries close Monday 30 September 2019

Enter online at www.equestrianentries.co.nz

Entries are required to be paid online at time of entry unless otherwise organised with the Hawkes Bay A&P Society.

Entries received after the closing date will not be catalogued.

The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate classes where insufficient entries are received.

RAS RULES

The RAS Judges & Competitors Rulebook (see www.ras.org.nz) sets out all the conditions that apply to the classes and sections offered. Each Breed that is affiliated to the RAS offer their own standard schedule of classes and any additional rules that apply to showing their particular breed.

SHOW LEVIES AND FEES

Judges Levy of \$5 per competitor for cattle and sheep entrants

Admin Fee of \$5 per competitor (non-refundable)

ALL NON-COMPETING DOGS ARE BANNED FROM THE HAWKE'S BAY SHOWGROUNDS

TICKETS AND PARKING PASSES

Show tickets, wristbands and parking passes will be posted once entries close. Please ensure your correct address is on Equestrian Entries when entering.

Gate Entry - All Competitors will be supplied with Wristbands. Wristbands are to be worn for the duration of the Show. Gate entry tickets will not be supplied to Horse Competitors.

The Show is open to the public from Wednesday 23 - Friday 25 October 2019. Wristbands must be worn by competitors.

Competitors with 1 or 2 animals receive 2 Wristbands, 3 and over will receive 3 Wristbands.

Additional Day Entry Tickets may be pre purchased at a reduced rate of \$8.00 per Adult and \$5.00 per child. Three-day passes can be purchased at time of entry for \$24 per adult and \$15 per child. These tickets can be purchased through Equestrian Entries prior to close of entries. After this, please contact Event Secretary entries@hawkesbayshow.co.nz

PRIZE MONEY

All prize money will be paid out after the show into a nominated bank account, please enter details on Equestrian Entries. This will be done (subject to any queries) within 30 days. Any disputes regarding prize money will be made no later than 30th November.

Hawke's Bay A&P Show Prizemoney will be scaled as follows:

If there are less than 4 starters in a class, only 1st place prize money will be awarded. If there are a minimum of four starters, 2nd place prize money will also be awarded. For more than 5 started in a class, prize money will be awarded to 3rd place.

ENTRY CONDITIONS

Run under the Rules and Regulations of the RAS and/or local conditions designated below.

Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable for any hazards created or accident, illness or damage caused by the action of themselves or their animals at the Showgrounds.

By entering this Show, exhibitors must comply with the appropriate animal Legislation the Health & Safety at Work Act 2015 (HWSA) and any amendments thereafter.

The entry closing date will be enforced. Entries received after **30 September** will be subject to a late entry fee and will not be listed in the catalogue.

Entry in the Show entitles the Hawke's Bay A&P Society to publish an Exhibitors' name in results and distribute with Exhibitor Lists.

The Society reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without adducing any reason for doing so.

Exhibitors must check their entry carefully. A confirmation of entries will be sent, it is the competitor's responsibility to check the details are correct. Once entries are catalogued, changes can be made but will not be reflected in the Catalogue.

Starting Times are approximate only but will be adhered to as closely as possible. Although it is provided that animals may compete in more than one class, any or all of such classes may be judged simultaneously at the convenience of the Judges or Stewards. In all such cases exhibitors having an exhibit entered in more than one class must elect in which class they compete.

SCRATCHING

Refunds will be paid out in full until the close of entry. Following this, 75% will be refunded until 5pm Tuesday 22 October 2019. After this, 50% will be refunded once Entry Secretary has been provided with a medical certificate or vet certificate. Email entries@hawkesbayshow.co.nz. Competitors are encouraged to do their scratchings via My Entries on Equestrian Entries.

BEHAVIOUR & CONDUCT

Yellow Card - This Show/Event supports the RAS 'Yellow Card' system.

A Yellow Card will be issued, In cases of offences in respect of abuse of animals or inappropriate behaviour as per the RAS Constitution and the RAS Rules & Regulations/Bylaws including the Equestrian Rulebook, the RAS affiliated Show/Event/registered Measuring Stand and their grounds and their duly appointed delegates may deliver to the Person Responsible a Yellow Warning Card (either immediately or within 10 days of the show) which suspends any penalty until possible new offences. Full wording of the 'Yellow Card' system is available to view on the RAS website – www.ras.org.nz.

Clean Sport Testing

Clean Sport - The Rules of the Royal A&P Society New Zealand in regard to Forbidden Substances apply. Competitors are advised that tests for forbidden substances may be carried out during the Show/Event and that testing of all animals is at the person

responsible's risk. Forbidden Substance - Any substance capable of affecting the speed, stamina, courage or conduct of a horse, pony, donkey or mule by its action upon the central or peripheral nervous system or the cardio-vascular, respiratory, alimentary, digestive, musculoskeletal or urogenital systems.
