PRIZEMONEY Prize Money for Champions and Supreme only Ribbons and prize cards will be awarded where applicable, across the section. Confirmation of entries will be sent to each exhibitor once their entry has been received by the Show. Tickets will be posted (one ticket per exhibitor) and will include information regarding delivery of entries, parking and Show maps.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR HandMADE SECTION An entry is eligible for one class only and are not to have been entered before.

The confirmation of entries sent with your tickets, must be attached to your entries.

Delivery of entries will be accepted at the Show Office (first floor on the Grandstand) the week before the Show between the hours of 8.30am and 5pm.

Entries can be delivered between 10am to 1pm on Sunday 20 October 2019 to the HandMADE Community area Under the Grandstand. Entries are to be delivered direct to Stewards.

Judging takes place between Sunday and Wednesday before the Show. Consideration will be given to the suitability of design, fabric, technique and finishing of the article being judged. Wearable articles must not have been worn prior to exhibiting.

All exhibits must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor.

All articles must be handmade unless otherwise stated in the class schedule and should have been completed within the last 12 months.

All exhibitors enter articles at their own risk. While all care is taken the Hawke's Bay A&P Society will not be responsible for loss, damage or incorrect delivery of any exhibit. Please make arrangements with your own insurance company if you wish to do so.

Entries can be collected at the conclusion of the Show, from 5pm on Friday 25 October, or from Tuesday 29 October.

Please note the change to entry fees and prizemoney this year.

Ribbons and prize cards will still be awarded where applicable.

9081	Woodcraft: Decorated Bowls <i>Wooden items which have been turned into a bowl shape which may be decorated, coloured, textured or otherwise enhanced. There is no size prescription. (Note change from Bowls.)</i>	EF: \$5.00
9082	Woodcraft: Constructed Piece <i>Do not have to be turned on a lathe. May be an object of multiple pieces eg. Small furniture, lidded boxes etc.</i>	EF: \$5.00

- 9083 Woodcraft: Plain Bowls EF: \$5.00
Wooden items which have been turned into a bowl shape finished on a lathe, all surfaces having been finished on a lathe. No detailing, decoration, colouring, texturing, embellishment or re-shaping with other tools. There is no size prescription. (This will exclude natural edged bowls which will be in Class 9091).
- 9084 Woodcraft: Plates / Platters EF: \$5.00
Wooden items, which may be decorated with other materials which have been turned to a plate/platter shape on a lathe, and may be decorated with other materials. The height must not exceed 20% of the diameter, eg. a 250 mm diameter piece must not exceed 50 mm in height.
- 9085 Woodcraft: Hollow Forms / Vases EF: \$5.00
Hollow forms are wooden items which have been turned on a lathe through a hole which is significantly smaller than the diameter of the finished work. Vases are wooden items which are at least twice as high as the greatest diameter and have been hollowed while turning on a lathe through the main opening. Both hollow forms and vases may be decorated with other materials.
- 9086 Woodcraft: Domestic Ware EF: \$5.00
Wooden items which may be decorated with other materials. This includes items such as rolling pins, spoons/scoops, egg cups, goblets, salt and pepper shakers, egg timers, lamp stands, stools and any other item the maker believes to be utilitarian in a domestic situation. Size not to exceed 1500 mm for the longest axis plus width and depth at the widest points measured at right angles to the longest axis.
- 9087 Woodcraft: Lidded Boxes EF: \$5.00
Any wooden item with a lid that fits into, or over the body of the work, to enclose a useable space within. Maximum size at the extremities 250 mm. (Note: This excludes making boxes which cannot be possibly used to contain anything useable.)
- 9088 Woodcraft: Ornamental EF: \$5.00
Any ornamental, sculptured or abstract item made of wood involving some use of the lathe in making; or carved turning being any item with more than 50% of the surface carved or textured; or marquetry, intarsia and scroll saw work which creates a recognisable picture from one or many pieces of wood.
- 9089 Woodcraft: Woodcarving EF: \$5.00
Any item carved from a single piece of wood, which may be decorated with other materials. Size not to exceed 1500 mm for the longest axis plus width and depth at the widest points measured at right angles to the longest axis, including any stand which supports the carved item. (Note: The size prescription of 400 x 400 x 900 mm has been substituted by the 1500 mm size prescription. This allows for a greater flexibility with a similar overall dimension.)
- 9090 Woodcraft: Toys EF: \$5.00
The item does not have to be turned on a lathe, but does need to be suitable, including finish, for children to be able to play with.
- 9091 Woodcraft: Natural EF: \$5.00
Any single piece of wood, which may be turned on a lathe or shaped with other tools, and retains a part of the natural surface of the wood as it was found, or after the bark has fallen off.
- 9092 Woodcraft: Novice EF: \$5.00
This class is open to turners who have been turning for one (1) year or less; or who belong to a Guild or Club, and are currently turning and/or operating within the Novice Class. Entries may include any item which has principally been turned on a lathe, but may also be decorated or shaped with other tools; and shall include items that would otherwise qualify for entry into the following seven (7) classes: Classes 9081, 9082, 9083, 9084, 9085, 9086 and 9087, subject to the requirement for it to be mainly a turned item.
