

Primary Sector Innovation Award

The Hawke's Bay Primary Sector Innovation Award will recognise outstanding innovation within the Hawke's Bay region.

The purpose of this award is to identify, acknowledge and celebrate those in Hawke's Bay who have made a significant contribution through their knowledge, skills and application to improve the performance of the primary industries.

This award is open to Primary Sector of all kinds. It includes software, products, services and any innovation targeted towards the primary sectors. It celebrates innovation in farming, fisheries, horticulture, viticulture, forestry, applied agricultural research including the companies that service these sectors. Innovation in this category may also overlap and connect with innovation in food & beverage and health & science.

Criteria

- Entry is open to individuals, organisations and businesses.
- Individuals must be either New Zealand citizens or permanent residents aged 18 and over at the time of entry (or 16, with guardian permission).
- Organisations must be registered in and have operations in New Zealand.
- The innovation, key business or key person must originate from or reside in the Hawke's Bay region.
- Uniqueness, impact, scalability, and innovation at every level. Tell us a story about the problem you're solving, why your solution is unique, who it is impacting AND in what metrics, how well you know your market and its size, and what direction is next for you.
- Tell us all about your innovative work and that of individuals that have made a significant or inspiring contribution to the project or to innovation in general. This is the moment for that individual or team to shine! You will need to provide the name of one person in the team to be the main contact who will represent your entry.

Entry Process

Entries are accepted from a nominee or from the individual, organisation or business.

Closing Date

Nominations close on the 14 February 2020.

Judging process

To be judged by a panel of three comprising a representative of the sponsor, a representative of the Hawke's Bay Agricultural and Pastoral Society and an independent primary sector leader.
