### Export Lamb Competition 2020

**Atkins Ranch, Progressive Meats and the Hawke's Bay A&P Society extend a warm welcome to all farmers to enter the Export Lamb Competition.**

The competition has a two-part judging process; on the hoof and on the hook.

### Atkins Ranch and Progressive Meats are Supporting YOUR Community!

Atkins Ranch and Progressive Meats Ltd encourage you to get involved in the Hawke's Bay Export lamb Competition!

Enter a pen of three lambs in either the new or old season class and **Atkins Ranch and Progressive Meats will donate \$100 to your rural playcentre, school, or community group of your choice!**



Stephenson's Transport have generously partnered with us to make it easier for you to be involved. We will be running a "stock drive" to collect lambs for delivery on judging day for those that require lambs to be picked up.

### CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The competition is open to all lamb producers, irrespective of supply relationships, between Wairoa and Dannevirke.
- \$20 entry fee per entry (GST and penning inclusive).
- A pen of three (3) lambs equals one entry.
- Entries will NOT be accepted on the day. Entries are limited to 270 lambs across both classes.
- All lambs must be GRASS FED, ANTIBIOTIC & GMO FREE and have FULL LIFETIME TRACEABILITY. This means all lambs must have never been fed grain or given antibiotics.
- All lambs must be outside any meat withholding period at time of competition and presented ready for slaughter.
- All entries must be accompanied with the latest version of the Atkins Ranch or Progressive Meats ASD Form with Quality Assurance Declaration completed.
- Old season lambs will be disqualified and downgraded to hogget's if they have one or more incisor in wear.
- All three (3) lambs must grade as per the requirements for each class to be eligible for the champion prizes.

### JUDGING

The pen of three (3) is judged on a combination of:

#### On the Hoof

- Condition,
- Conformation
- Presentation
- *With an even line of lambs gaining more points and extra points for Judges Pick.*

#### On the Hook

- Dress Out Yield (DOY),
- Hot Carcass Weight (HCW)
- GR (target GR is 8 – 10mm).
- *Competitors will receive individual lamb results for DOY, HCW and GR.*

16.0 – 23.9kg HCW, 4 – 20mm GR (Targets: 17-19kg HCW and 8-10mm GR)

Best Pen of 3 on Hook – 1st \$100,

**Champion New Season Lamb line combined Hoof & Hook – \$150**

### 5312 ATKINS RANCH OLD SEASON LAMB (over 6 months of age)

18.0 – 25.9kg HCW, 4 – 20mm GR (Targets: 20-22kg HCW and 8-10mm GR) all lambs will be mouthed – Hogget's are not accepted and will be disqualified.

Best Pen of 3 on Hoof – 1st \$100

Best Pen of 3 on Hook – 1st \$100

**Champion Old Season Lamb line combined Hoof & hook – \$150**

### SUPREME CHAMPION CARCASS (across both new and old season lambs)

The Supreme Carcass - ideal weight 22kg HCW, 8mm GR, best Dress Out Yield.

**There can be only one SUPREME CARCASS \$300**

### Rosettes and certificates presented for 1<sup>st</sup> place.

Prize money will be paid into your nominated bank account.

Kill proceeds will be paid 14 days after kill, direct to competitors less normal kill charges on the Atkins Ranch schedule on the day.
